



NDTA™ CONTEMPORARY PRACTICE MODEL CERTIFICATE COURSE

IN THE MANAGEMENT OF ADULTS WITH STROKE AND BRAIN INJURY

COURSE OVERVIEW

This fifteen-day course in the management of adults with neurological dysfunction due to stroke or brain injury is based on the philosophy and basic principles of Dr. Karel and Mrs. Berta Bobath. The NDT Approach has since continued to evolve with new research findings and current evidence guiding clinical practice.

The course format includes lectures, laboratory practice sessions, patient demonstrations by the instructors, treatment of patients by course participants, and small group work. There will be written work including an exam at course completion.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Participants will have the opportunity to increase their ability to:

- Apply the principles of NDT to the management of the adult client.
- Better assess and analyze normal and abnormal movement.
- Identify impairments interfering with function.
- Integrate the approach to management with concepts of neuroplasticity, recovery of function, and motor learning theory.
- Develop handling skills useful in facilitating normal function.
